Instructions for Completing Application for Transfer

Fill out in ink or indelible pencil. If an error is made above, mark VOID and complete a separate transfer application.

THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF AFFCAP READ:

“Every change in ownership of a registered animal shall be promptly recorded with AFFCAP by the seller, in order that progeny of the animal may be registered and subsequent changes in ownership recorded.

Any change in ownership that will also require a change in the name of the recorded owner on the registration certificate must be reported immediately to the Foundation on an application, completed in every detail including without limitation of the generality of the foregoing: (1) new owner's name and address; (2) date of sale; (3) if the animal is female, whether or not she has been served and, if served, the date of the service and the name and registration number of the service bull, together with the proper fee.”

Open Transfers (defined to be applications for transfer which do not include the names of the buyers of the animals) are condemned and declared to be in violation of these Bylaws and subject to disciplinary action of the Board of Directors. All transfer fees are to be paid by the seller of an animal.”

The Association’s Bylaws require the seller to pay the transfer fee.

Mail at time of sale for lowest fee and/or submit by internet.

Please remit by check or money order. If cash is sent, register the letter.

1. Print name of buyer and write in the complete address.

2. Write in Name of Animal

3. Mark Sex of Animal

4. Write date of sale.

5. Record AFFCAP ear tag number

6. Record Service Bull Name the AFFCAP farm number. If female is not carrying calf at date of sale, write NOT SERVED in the space provided for the service bulls name.

7. List the animal registration number.

8. Mark the date the cow has been served

9. Or, mark the dates the cow was serve in field. If a female being transferred was served before the date of sale and has not yet calved, the name and number of the bull and the date of service must be written on the application. If bred artificially, please attach A.I. receipt OR accept full responsibility for any damages resulting from inaccurate breeding information.

10. Sign Transfer Application, The seller must sign personally and give his/her complete mailing address or the correct owner number.

11. Provide AFFCAP Farm Number

12. If there has been a change of address, provide details in the spaces provided

Proper Fees Must Accompany All Applications

The following fees are for transfers using this form. Effective August 2nd, 2012. Rs 250.00 if application is received within 60 days of the date of sale of the animal to the new owner/buyer.

Rs 350.00 if application is received after 60 days of the date of sale of the Animal to the new owner/buyer.

Rs 100.00 after public or private dispersal of enrolled herd, provided application received within 60 days of sale. This requires a minimum of three years continuous program enrollment.

Rs 0.00 if transferred to heirs of an estate by reason of the death of owner **provided all living animals in the one ownership are transferred at the same time** and within one (1) year of the owner's death.

Rs 50.00 from one ownership to another member of the immediate family (husband, wife, father, mother, son, daughter, son-in-law, daughter-in-law brother, sister, brother-in-law, and sister-in-law) of the prior owner, OR to form or dissolve a partnership in which the prior owner becomes a partner, or in which a partner or partners succeed as owner, **provided all living animals in the one ownership are transferred at the same time.**
